Online Professional Learning Graduate Course (3 credits)

EDU 620 Mentoring in Action: Becoming a Qualified Mentor and Leader MA DESE requires mentor training.

Designed for mentors in training, current mentors who want to refresh and update their skills, and mentor leaders who are designing mentor training programs.

In this course you will learn how to;

-  1) **use a mentoring curriculum** to design purposeful mentoring conversations
-  2) **align mentoring** conversations to Educator Evaluation standards rubric
-  3) **differentiate** mentoring conversations to meet the varied needs of novice teachers in your district (including teachers beyond year 1)
-  4) **learn** about mindfulness and **become a mentor leader**.

Seven online modules include videos, articles, and reflection questions.

An experienced online mentor reads and responds to all your reflections and customizes assignments as needed.

COST \$595 (per course) INCLUDES: 3 graduate credits (67.5 PDPs) and an online mentor. The content includes videos, readings, and reflections. A final e-journal reflection is required to verify successful completion.
