Graduate Course (3 credits)

- ✚ **EDU 646 Mindful Teaching: Refining Your Practice to Support Student Learning** This course is aligned to the MA *Standards for Effective Teaching Practices*. All assignments may be used as evidence to document Educator Evaluation or SMART Goals.
- ✚ In this course you will: 1) modify or create a student survey to learn your students' perspectives.
- ✚ 2) reflect on your teaching practices as they relate to each of the four rubric standards
- ✚ 3) learn mindfulness strategies to minimize stress. Five online modules include videos, articles, and reflections.

Designed for novice teachers who want to document 50 hours of required mentoring (after year 1), experienced teachers who want to document evidence for Educator Evaluation, and teachers on Ed Plans who want to improve teaching practices.

COST \$595 (per course) INCLUDES: 3 graduate credits (67.5 PDPs) and an online mentor. The content includes videos, readings, and reflections. A final e-journal reflection is required to verify successful completion.
